

WIC Participation with WIC-Accepting Clinics and Retailers

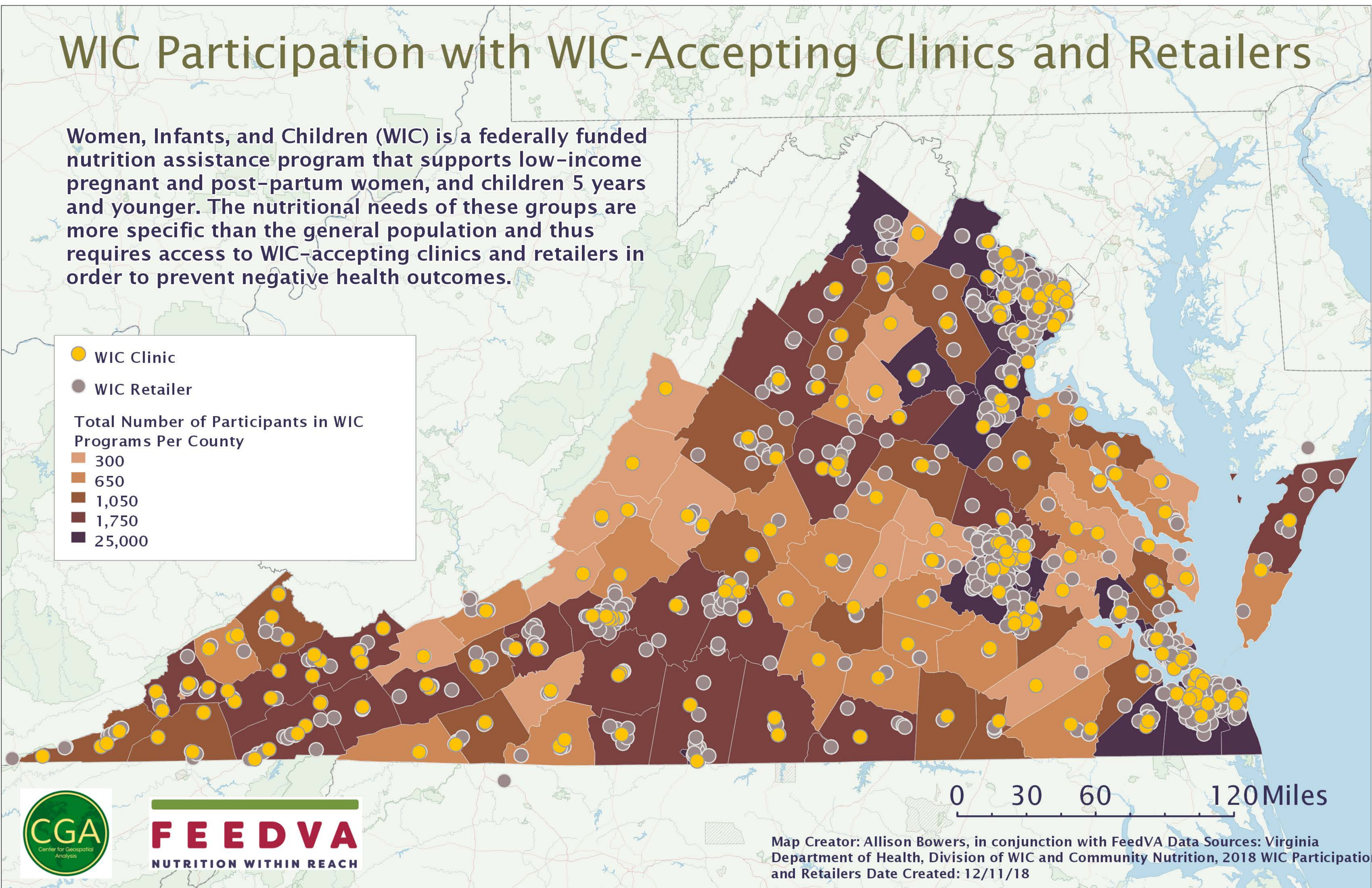
Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) is a federally funded nutrition assistance program that supports low-income pregnant and post-partum women, and children 5 years and younger. The nutritional needs of these groups are more specific than the general population and thus requires access to WIC-accepting clinics and retailers in order to prevent negative health outcomes.
